



Ballet Forum Information Sheet

Students of Ballet Forum will have Assigned Ballrooms.
All Ballet Forum attendees must be registered for the Summer SADM Convention.

The Ballet Forum is a 2-day ballet intensive workshop providing students ages 11-21 years of age. If your student is 11 years old, they must have had 1 year of Intro to Ballet Forum OR 4 years of Ballet Training. If your student is 12 years and up they must have a minimum of 2 years of ballet training. Your student will have the opportunity to study with a professional classical ballet faculty. Along with technique classes each day, there will be two special performance pieces choreographed and taught by the distinguished ballet forum faculty in a ballet company atmosphere.

The pieces will be performed at the annual SADM Banquet on Saturday evening.

To assure individual attention, participants are divided into two Forums based on age and advancement. The purpose of the placement class is to allow the Choreographers the opportunity to observe the students prior to the choreography classes.

Attendance at the placement class is mandatory along with a rehearsal Saturday at 4pm.

Final placement is reserved at the discretion of our Professional Ballet Faculty

Pointe Work Without the Barre - bourees, sous-sus, piques, echappe, simple turns, passe and releve
